I. PURPOSE

To inform website visitors about the techniques and tools Morris County uses to make its websites accessible.

II. POLICY

The following verbiage shall be posted on all public-facing and internal county websites, including those of any County department, agency, board, commission or authority:

The Morris County [agency or web site name] has endeavored to make this site accessible to the widest variety of users with differing needs by using various technologies. This site pursues the following standards for content delivery and accessibility:

- Pages are coded with HTML 5.0
- Formatting is done with Cascading Style Sheets using CSS 3 Specifications
- Images are described with ALT tags
- Image maps are not used
- Alternates are provided for uses of javascript throughout the website

All pages are designed with Web Content Accessibility Guidelines in mind. Care has been taken to have sufficient contrast in typed matter for readability. Visitor browser preferences may affect the site's appearance somewhat but efforts have been made to retain the site's overall visual layout.
